RENOVATED BUILDING AWARD

– renovated extra service facility

This award is for the renovation of an existing aged care facility or an existing building which has been converted to an aged care facility that meets current certification requirements and shows some of the following features:

- innovative application of space within the building footprint
- creative layout and space utilisation
- innovative use of building finishes
- innovative building fabric
- innovative design

SUBMISSIONS MUST INCLUDE:

- design brief - half a page
- operational brief - half a page
- mission statement for facility - 4 lines
- company philosophy - 4 lines
- how you see the future of aged care - 4 lines
- how the building relates to the future - 4 lines
- list of equipment used in laundry and kitchen and why (if applicable)
- what you are trying to achieve with this facility - 4 lines

SUBMISSIONS TO CONSIST OF:

- 4 large colour photos of residents' accommodation, preferably A4 (can be computer printed)
- 2 colour photos of residents' bathrooms
- 6 colour photos of external elevations
- 4 colour photos of outlook in each direction
- 4 colour photos of entry and reception area
- 2 colour photos of courtyards or gardens

GUIDELINES FOR APPLICATIONS:

- *New Building Award* — applications will only be accepted for buildings that are fully constructed, commissioned and made operational within the last two years.
- *Renovated Building Award* — applications will only be accepted for buildings that have been renovated within the last two years.

If you are applying for more than one award please submit a separate application for each and address the appropriate criteria for that award category.

All finalists are requested to attend the Awards Ceremony at the ACAA 29th Annual Congress, for the winner announcements. The 2010 Congress will be held at the Adelaide Convention Centre from 14-16 November.

All applicants are invited to be included in the poster board display at the Congress. Specifications will be provided to all applicants at a later date.

All winning applicants will be given the opportunity to be interviewed for an article which will appear in the Association's national magazine 'Aged Care Australia'.
